Named for the Latin root of the small town of Tivoli, Italy, travertine is a type of sedimentary limestone rock that has been used as a building material for thousands of years. As Travertine never has a single solid colour, it is favoured by designers for the rich colourations and veining that run throughout the stone. Travertine offers distinctively warm, earthy tones that range from soft ivories to bold pewters, with rich shades of gold, silver and deep mocha browns. And as no two tiles are ever the same, the unique beauty of a travertine tile floor is always the focal point of any room.

Slate is an exotic natural stone prized for its smooth, fine-grained appearance that offers a distinctive beauty as a flooring surface. A distinctively beautiful flooring surface, slate is naturally durable, slip-resistant, non-staining, resistant to moisture, and it is often chosen specifically for

foyers, hallways and in bathrooms with under floor heating. Slate flooring is also favoured for its wide spectrum of unique colour variations that include charcoal black, rusty reds, grey/greens, deep maroons and unique mixtures that add to its ability to create a refined, sophisticated space.

Once installed, a properly sealed stone floor requires little regular maintenance beyond a good dry dust mop to gently remove debris. Left unattended, dirt and grit can become abrasive and scratch the flooring material. Cleaning stone floors generally only requires a lightly dampened mop or the use of a mild neutral stone soap solution. Over time, stone flooring may need to be re-sealed depending upon the amount of foot traffic.

Choosing stone flooring for your home will immediately retire your vacuum cleaner, enhance any room's beauty, and certainly improve the value of the property.
